Miss Jade was able to extend on this and we asked Miss Hannah if we could use her dinosaurs in her room as they are so




# Having Fun & Exploring

Exploring animals helps children with their gross motor skills and body awareness. Their social and communication skills are developed by playing with friends!




# Analysis of learning
