


WELCOME VIOLET


Violet enjoyed investigating the coloured animals and bears. Using her investigation skills she identified the different animals.

Children's Choice





Selecting some of the food he placed it into the microwave before turning it on and watching till it was finished. Olivia enjoyed spending time playing with Nathaniel this morning. In the book corner Miss Jade sat with Spencer, Yoonu and Hanson and read some of the story books. Yoonu also spent some time playing with the small safari truck and the bottom of the magnetic car.


