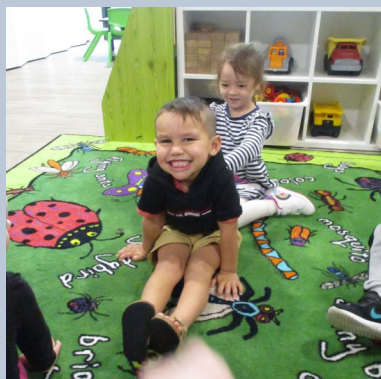

Exploring our emotions

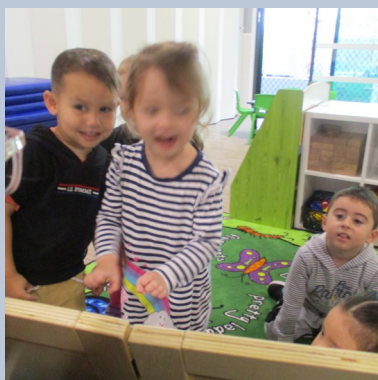


A big emotions chart has been put up in the Dolphins room for children to look at and identify and they and others might be feeling by looking at their body language and facial expressions.

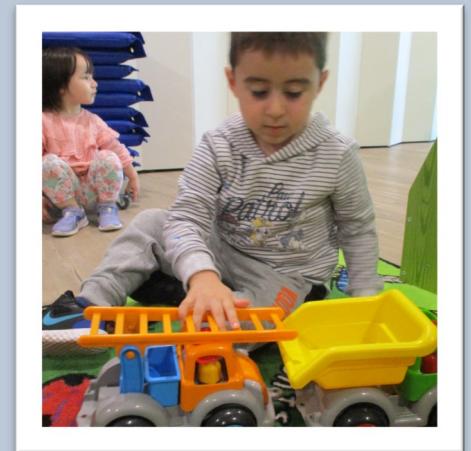
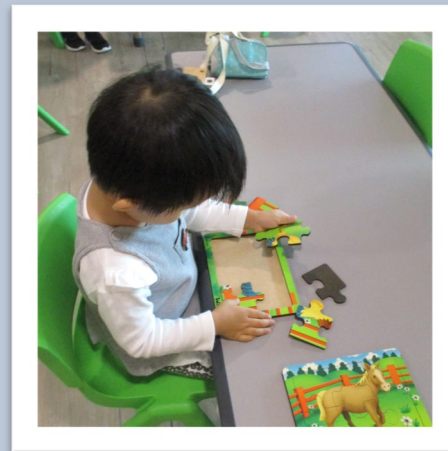
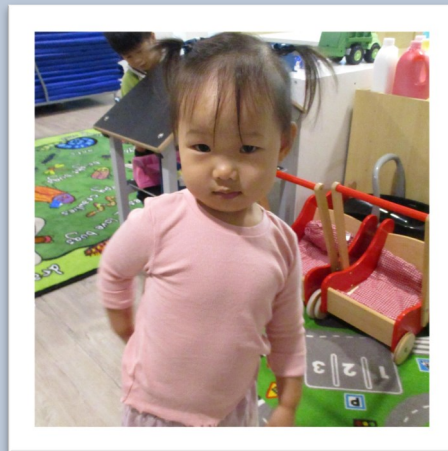
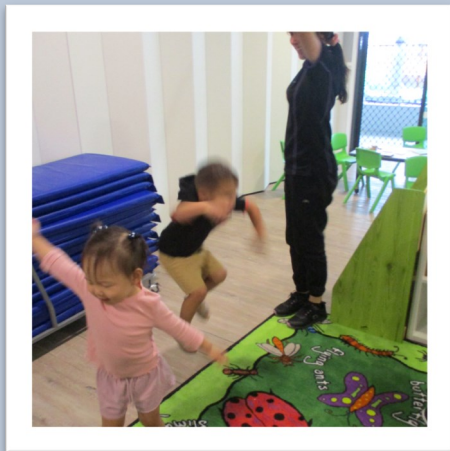
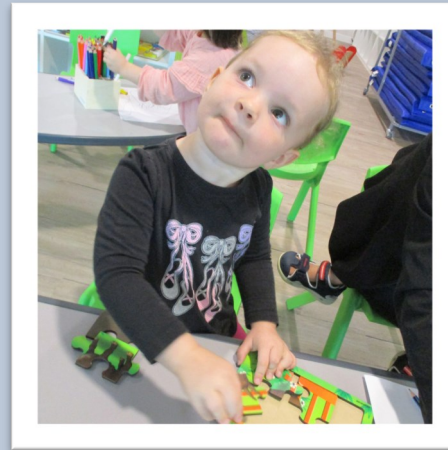
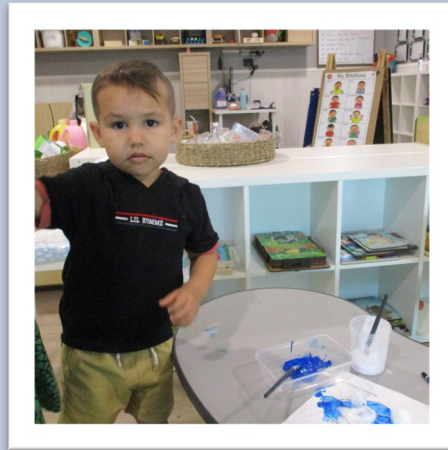


Reflection of the day
