


Jellyfish's Daily Learning Story

Welcome Tabitha!





Today was a very special day as we got to welcome Tabitha into our joyful Jellyfish room.

Welcome to the Jellyfish room Tabitha, we are all very excited to have you in our room!






Frozen Water Paints

What an amazing day we have had in our Jellyfish Room. Our activity for the day was Frozen water paints.

How excited were we when Miss Zoe brought them in the room, we had the colours purple, pink, yellow, green and orange. They looked like mini ice blocks.

Amal was very particular and wanted to use her pink and purple paints to draw on a blue coloured paper, Archie and Amelia were more interested in how it felt on their hands and then Amelia eagerly wanted to taste the blue one. Zaidyn on the other hand used his fine motor skills to hit his popsicle stick on the his paper which he thought was a bit funny.

This activity was very engaging for our children it showed a variety of ways we could use frozen water paints. So much interactions with all children involved. As well as exploring there sense of touch when they felt the texture and coldness of the ice.





Analysis of learning




