Archie was very excited to be able to do his handprint first, sitting on the chair patiently waiting for Miss Zoe to paint his hand.




Amal loves using her hands to create artworks, taking her time pressing her hand on the brown piece of paper. She created a beautiful handprint for herself.





Amal explored lots of different areas outside this morning, she had some fun racing around on the bike and trying to spin the hula hoop around her waist.
