# Welcome to the Seahorse Room Sai!




Settling into a new environment with new people and without the security of your parents is never an easy task to achieve but you were so brave.



Marwin and Keaston were exploring all the different toys, finding balls, bikes, and animals to entertain one another!



With all the Seahorse children were super excited when they heard the beginning of the song, we all started to do the actions!
