


# Stingrays, Sharks and Whales daily story

Elora and Ellie were the first to join in on the gardening and investigated the different sizes of the seeds.





The girls had to guess if they thought the seeds were big or small by listening to Miss Hannah shake the different packets they came in.


# Reflection of the day

We have finally finished our Anzac poppies and they are going to look great in reception as part of a display to help commemorate Anzac Day.




