Using food colouring mixed with water, the children used paint brushes to apply the tinted water to already dampened paper.



The children had to work quickly to brush the paint on, whirling and twirling their brushes around the flowers as Miss Caitlin encouraged them to go faster and faster!






Writing our names

The children have been practising writing their names down in the sign-in book.




The book is kept in Miss Hannah's room and you can help your child to "sign in" for the day by letting them trace over their names.
