Today we shared with the children and opportunity to explore the natural wonders of our earth through sensory exploration, looking, touching and developing an appreciation of what is in our environment.

We explored sand and water and the effects the two have on each other creating a scientific curiosity for the children as it change the texture and sensation of the sand. We then added some feathers, straw, leaves and hessian, which they also explored the texture.

Then the children used these additional materials in the sand as decorative items, focusing on placement of each item with purpose.




Group Time


I Had a Little Turtle

Bubble, PoP!




Spontaneous activities
