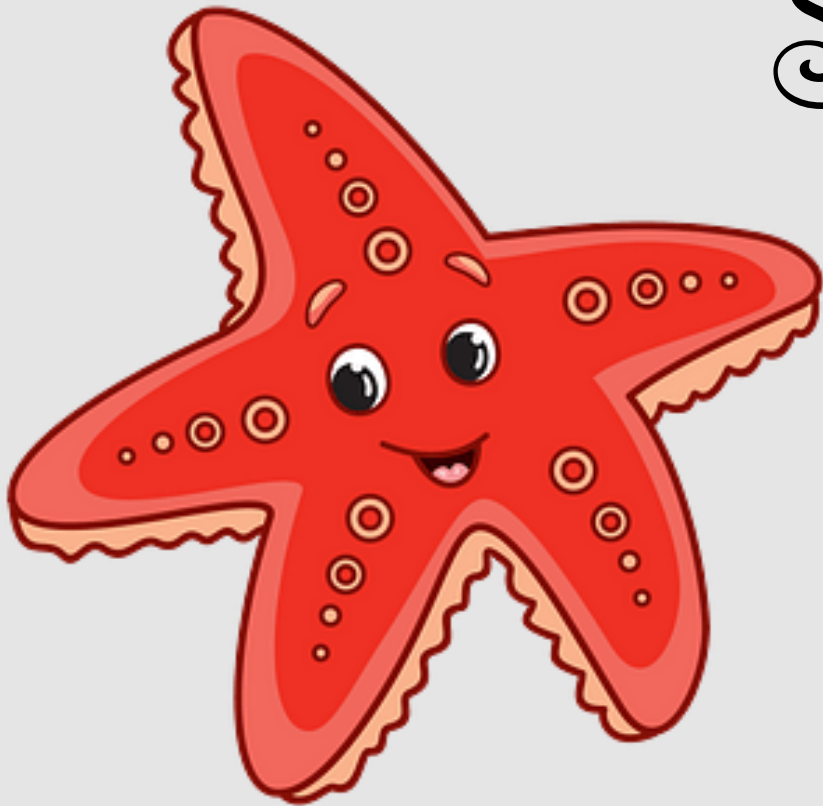

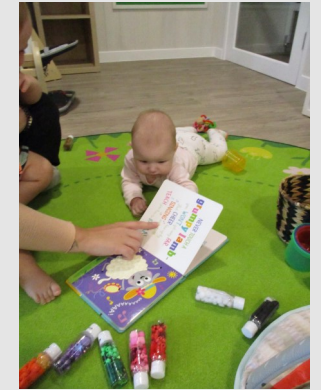


Sensory coloured bottles
