On some white paper Miss Briohny stuck on some star and moon outlines and provided the children with purple and blue paint. Using the paint brushes the children were able to cover their paper, covering the shapes with paint. When they were finished Miss Briohny used some white paint and a tooth brush to add some tiny stars. Once our paintings are dry we will remove the star and moon shape to see the pattern it has left.



GROUP TIME

We engaged in our first group time of the week today. Sitting together on the mat the children and Miss Briohny went over their numbers from 1 to 5 using the flashcards. Looking at the pictures the children used their recognition skills to identify the insects that were on the cards. We looked at the numbers and Miss Briohny helped the children to identify them and what they looked liked using out fingers. Once we had done our numbers a few times we read “Don’t eat the baby sitter’. The children enjoyed this book as it was about sharks and Miss Briohny made the story funny.
