Reconciliation week art!



What a fun art experience to start reconciliation week in the Jellyfish room. Miss Taylah had saved the black, yellow and red tissue paper from yesterday's sensory play for today's art experience. Miss Taylah had set up at the table with the container of tissue paper, glue and paper. **Olivia** was the first to race to the table, **Ethan** and **Chloe** followed and waited patiently by **Olivia's** side for their turn. **Olivia** softly spread the glue across the her paper then with big handfuls she placed down the coloured tissue paper onto her paper and clapped as she showed how proud she was of her creativity. sensory for reconciliation week.


