Group time



Thumb is curved, pointer points


Fingers on the side and take them for a ride



Bubble wrap painting

The bubble wrap left marks that looked a bit like snake scales!





We hope to continue the fun tomorrow!







The children had so much fun playing with shaving foam to write letters and draw shapes.
