Nathaniel, Spencer, Mikayla and Yoonu enjoyed some dancing with Miss Taylah and Miss Zoe this morning. After dancing, Miss Tanya used some fishing line and hung up some balloons with water in them for the children to play with. They spent the rest of the morning running around pushing and kicking the balloons and then trying to catch them again. This activity helped the children to strengthen their gross motor skills while also working on their hand-eye coordination skills. The children had so much fun playing with the balloons.



# NEWSPAPER COLLAGE



As tomorrow is World Environment Day the children created their own recycled collages this morning. Using one of the paint brushes and some glue they brushed it over their page in circles or lines. Once they were finished they selected different sized and shapes pieces of newspaper and placed them onto the paper. By using the newspaper we were recycling and reusing an old product and turning it into something new. This also provided the children with a different media to work with.

Next week we will continue to work with recycled materials and make a variety of different arts and craft.



# CHILDREN'S CHOICE



Spencer and Mikayla took turns pushing each other around in the pram this morning. They showed great sharing and turn taking skills as well as demonstrating their kindness and caring skills.

While Violet worked with the ribbon reels and pieces of straw. This activity provided the children with the opportunity to explore their creativity.



Spencer, Nathaniel and Yoonu worked on the shape puzzle this morning. Looking through the different shapes they selected the shapes they needed to complete the picture on their card. Using their fine motor skills they grasped the shapes between their fingers before lining them up with the gaps on the cards.

As a group the children took turns recognising the different pictures and placing them onto the compost bin. We also talked about what types of things can be recycled in the cans bin. Next week we will start to read some stories about recycling and encouraging the children to actively recycle during the week.









# Reflection of the day
