
- Yogurt tops (twist lids)

SMALL WORLD AIRPORT



Today we started our topic of learning about planes. On the mirror table Miss Briohny set up a small world in the design of an airport. In the airport there were a variety of planes. The planes were made from pegs and paddle pop sticks and painted in different colours. This activity provided the children with the opportunity to engage in small group play or to enjoy solitary play. Selecting one of the planes they chose to either drive it down the runway or pretended to fly it around. The children spent a good portion of the morning playing with the planes and exploring their creativity. We will continue to provide the children to explore the small world as well as adding some other transport vehicles to the play like helicopters.



CARDBOARD TUBE PLANES



As we started our topic of planes today the children started their design of their cardboard tube planes. Selecting one of the tubes they used the pastel paints to cover the outside of the tubes.

This activity encouraged the children to use their problem solving skills as they had to discover a way in which they could hold the tube while painting the outside.

Once our plane bodies are dry the children will choose some wings a tail before gluing them onto their planes. We will also look at a way to display them in the room.



GROUP TIME

The children joined Miss Briohny on the mat this morning for our group time. Today we talked about 'Things that fly' using picture cards. Looking at the pictures the children used their recognition skills to identify the pictures they were familiar with. We learnt that along with planes, helicopters, kites, birds, bees, butterflies, hot air balloons, bats, kites, drones and frisbees can fly. Once we finished talking about the pictures the children were provided with the opportunity to select what they wanted to learn about next week.

Spencer chose birds

Yoonu selected bees

Keaston chose hot air balloons

Olivia selected bats

Nathaniel selected kites.

We have a couple of busy weeks ahead of us as we continue to learn about planes and helicopters before starting to learn about other things that fly.

Maybe everyone can ask their mums and dads if they can come up with some other topics that fly and let Miss Briohny know.
