Stingray parents:



# PEG PLANES

We continued with our topic of planes today, by working with the children to create their own planes. Sitting at the table Miss Briohny gave the children a wooden peg each along with two and a half paddle pop sticks. Using the paints that they requested, yellow, pink, blue and orange, they worked to paint each part of their planes. As they were painting the children decided to create multicoloured planes by mixing the colours together. Once the parts of the plane are dry we will work to connect them together to form the planes. Miss Briohny will then put some string on the planes and create a mobile we can hang outside.

Tomorrow the children will make some shape collage helicopters.



# MUSIC



Mr Brendan came today for music with the children. To start the children recapped on what they have learnt so far before listening to a song and putting the different lessons into action. They also learn how to add the different movements together, like stamping their feet and clapping at the same time. Instead of standing up and dancing this morning the children set together on the turf and we danced along to the songs, stamping our feet, clapping our hands, freezing and making up some unique dance moves.



# OUTDOOR

We had an outdoor day today as we need to clean the room again. The children chose to engage in a variety of different experiences. Azalea spent some time playing with the LOL dolls in the dolls house while Yoonu and Hanson took turns playing with the car and ramp. Holding onto the car they dropped it at the top of the ramp and watched it slide all the way to the bottom. The children also enjoyed riding the bikes as well as playing with the big ball and the dinosaurs on the mat.



In the mud kitchen this morning Spencer and Nathaniel played together. Spencer stood on the outside of the kitchen, talking to Nathaniel through the window and Nate handed Spencer some different foods. Once they had their food they sat down together at the picnic table and used the spoons to eat their food. Hanson, Yoonu, Azalea and Xin Yan also joined in with playing in the mud kitchen. Once they had selected the food and containers they wanted to use they sat down around the picnic table. Azalea showed kindness as she offered some pizza to Xin Yan. While playing in the mud kitchen the children expressed their creativity while also transferring their knowledge from their home environment to the play environment.



# TRANSPORT SORT



Looking at the vehicles the children used their recognition skills and knowledge to sort the pictures and to match them where they belong. This activity allowed the children to demonstrate their knowledge while also working to explore their interests.




# Reflection of the day
