HOT AIR BALLOON





OUTDOOR PLAY:

The children spent some time playing outside before we had morning tea. In one of the gardens we set up a small world environment for the animals. Selecting either the pink or blue tepee, Nathaniel, Mikayla and Spencer opened the doors and placed the small dolls inside.




CREPE PAPER HOT AIR BALLOONS



As we continued learning about things that fly the children made their own hot air balloons today. Using glue they covered their balloon pictures, ensuring they had enough glue. Once they were finished with the glue they selected the coloured crepe paper they wanted to work with and started sticking it onto the balloon shape. The children created some amazing hot air balloons and when they are dry we will put them up in the room for everyone to see.



SMALL WORLD PLAY:



As today's topic was hot air balloons, Miss Briohny made some hot air balloons out of two recycled yoghurt containers, a couple of straws and a paper bag. On the little mirror table we set up the small airport world for the children to play with. To extend the world we added the two hot air balloons and some of the LOL dolls as passengers. Hanson and Marwin enjoyed playing with the hot air balloons, swapping out the LOL dolls and flying them around. The children enjoyed driving the cars around the table with the dolls and flying the planes.

While playing with the vehicles and the little dolls the children used their imagination and creativity to share their own stories.



MUSIC:

Mr Brendan came today for music with the children. They demonstrated their knowledge and memory skills as they were able to recall the different actions that they have been shown over the weeks. They remembered how to clap to the beat and how to stamp to the beat as well as making the 'tsss' sound with their mouths.


Today they also learnt how to listen to the count of four and clap twice or stamp twice.





Reflection of the day
