BUTTERFLY PAINTING

Today was our last day of our 'Things that Fly' topic and to finish our topic the children did butterfly painting. Dipping the paintbrush into the paint pots they covered them with paint before tapping them onto the paper. The children took their time creating spots of colour across the page, making different patterns. Once they were finished Miss Briohny helped by folding the paper in half and the children ran their hand across it to spread the paint. Once we were sure the paint was spread evenly Miss Briohny opened the paper up showing us the patterns we made. Each of the children had a turn creating their butterfly painting this morning and when they were finished Spencer and Mikayla asked if they could do some more painting.



















MAGNIFYING GLASSES AND PONIES













In small groups of two to three the children engaged in the magnifying glass activity. Selecting one of the magnifying glasses they picked up some of the small my little ponies and held it up to the glasses. Looking through the magnifying glasses the children got a deeper look at the colours and designs of the ponies. Thomas decided he was going to take his magnifying glass and look at different things around the room. While back at the table Mikayla and Violet took turns looking at each other through the magnifying glasses. Xin Yan also looked at Miss Briohny through the magnifying glass.

This activity provided the children with the opportunity to explore their scientific thinking and to explore the world around them in greater detail.

















Hello Mummy, Hello Daddy.

The children created their own phone this morning using the magnetic blocks. Mi-kayla, Spencer, Nathaniel, Hanson, Violet and Yoonu selected one of the curved blocks before attaching one of the magnetic balls to both ends to form the shape of their phones. Once their phones were ready they went around the room talking to their mummies and daddies. Mikayla brought her phone to Miss Briohny and said it was mummy, Miss Briohny also had to talk to Spencer and Nathaniel's daddies when they brought the phones over. The children enjoyed pretending to talk on the phones. Miss Jade sat with Yoonu and Thomas on the mat connecting with the magnetics.


While using the magnetics the children transferred their creative thinking skills and made connections between their home world and their play environment.


