


# FIREFIGHTER HANDPRINTS



Today our topic was firefighters as we continued learning about emergency services. To learn about firefighters the children created their own little firemen using hand paint.

With red paint, we painted the children's hands before they pressed them onto the white paper. Once the children had finished their handprints Miss Briohny gave them each a baby wipe to clean their hands. When we wake up this afternoon, we will glue some fire helmets on our fingers as well as drawing on their faces and the hose they are using to put the fire out. We will also add a little poem to their pictures.



# EMERGENCY SERVICES



Miss Briohny created an Emergency Services folder for the children to look through. In the folder there are pictures of the Police and the different modes of transport they use like boats, horses and motor bikes. There are also pictures of Firefighters and aspects of their jobs, like putting out fires and their uniforms. Along with some information about paramedics.



Along with looking through the folder the children engaged in the emergency services matching activity. Looking at the flashcards they worked on matching the emergency worker to the vehicle they use. After matching each of the vehicles they were able to match some of the pictures to the pictures in the folder.
