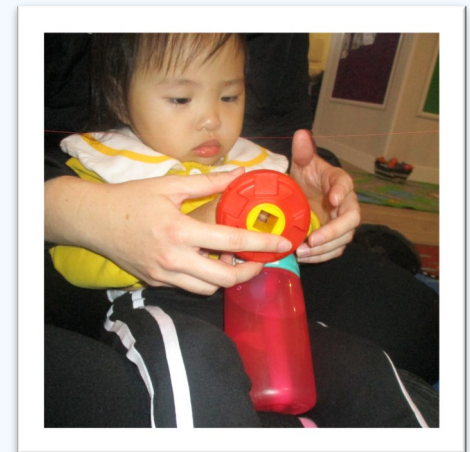
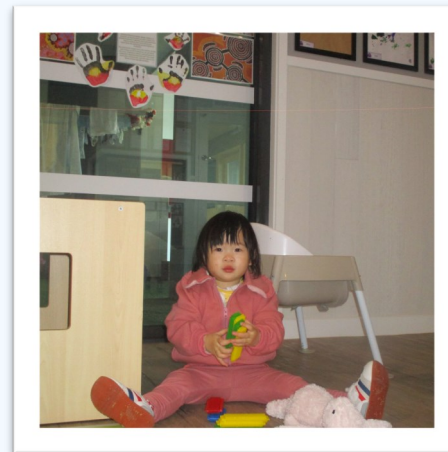
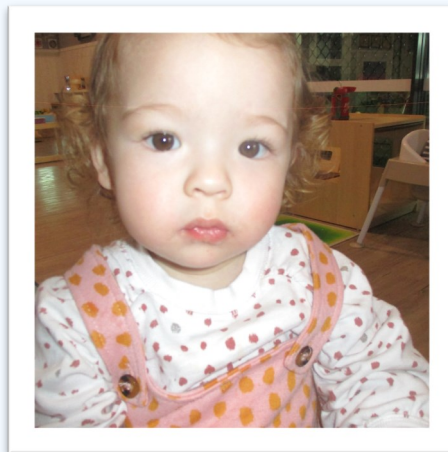
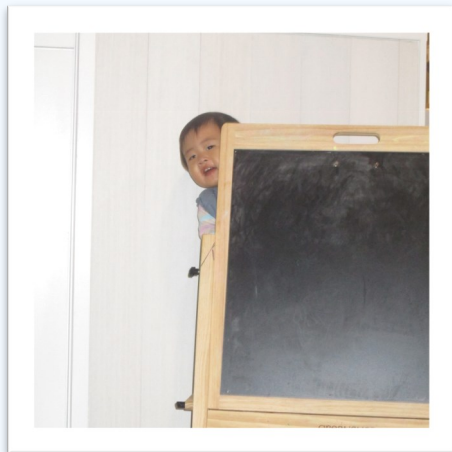
Reflection of the day
