Dot Painting

Today is the last day of National Reconciliation week, exploring the aboriginal culture through art, sensory and craft has been such a great way for the children to get in touch with different cultures and this one in particular, they have shown such a great interest in the different ways we have explored this culture.

Today's art experience involved the three indigenous flag colours, red, black and yellow, we used cotton tips and dipped them into the paint and painted some boomerangs. 
