


Daily Learning Story

Good afternoon families and friends. We hope you had a wonderful weekend and we're so happy to see everyone's smiley face this morning.




Miss Hannah is back from holidays!!



The children were so excited to see her this morning. Miss Hannah started the morning off by reading everyone a book called “Who’s at the zoo?”




