


## WEEKLY TOPIC: PERSONAL HYGIENE

# GERM COLLAGE

As we continued learning about our personal hygiene today, we focused on germs. For Arts and Craft the children selected one of the two germ outlines and used a variety of materials to collage their germ. Using the glue stick they spread the glue across their paper before spreading out the crepe paper, wrapping paper and foam shapes. Once they were finished they each chose the amount of eyes they would like to complete their germs. As each germ does not look the same the children's germs are unique as well, ranging from one eye to having six eyes.




# GERM I SPY












# Reflection of the day
