



Construction Sensory Tray

Continuing on with exploring construction, Miss Taylah set up a fun sensory tray with natural coloured playdough, leaves, sand, bark, foam rocks and the trucks and diggers. The Jellyfish children waited very patiently as Miss Taylah set up the experience outside.

Once Miss Taylah had finished setting up the experience, it was time for the Jellyfish children to come outside, investigate and explore. **Ayden** dived straight into the playdough, squishing it around in his hands and trying to roll it around in his hands, creating a ball, **Ayden** enjoyed pushing the trucks and diggers through the tray. **Tiffany** and **Tabitha** both jumped straight into exploring the tray, they showed a great interest in it straight away, **Tabitha** grabbed ahold of the playdough and began picking at it, pulling it apart and making it crumble, where **Tiffany** was squishing it in her hands and filling up the back of the trucks. **Chloe** wasn't overly sure about the tough tray as it was a little overwhelming with lots of things going on, she picked up a small ball of playdough and quietly explored it, maneuvering it around her hands. **Amelia** was also a little shy with the tough tray to begin with, but once she had seen her friends getting involved and engaging with one another she became comfortable and started to explore the tray, at first she enjoyed exploring the different coloured natural playdough, then moved onto the trucks and diggers.

Throughout this group experience, the children showed great interest and really engaged with one another, babbling along to each about what they could recognize, through verbal and non-verbal communication. The Jellyfish children, shared the playdough, trucks and diggers with one another and really got involved in the different sounds Miss Taylah, Miss Zoe and Miss Jade were making, that involved the trucks and the sounds they make.







Reflection of the day
