# FAMILY TREES

# FARM BOX

The children enjoyed playing with the animals they also added some of the cards to their play. This activity encouraged the children to share and take turns with the toys.

As we had a combined group he kept it simple and just went over the things that all of the children already know including clapping, stomping, symbols, dance and freeze. Thomas impressed Mr B during the song as he was able to remember what came next. Spencer, Phillip and Thomas had a great time with the dance and freeze. We even finished the last song with a superhero pose which the children liked. Even though the children weren't able to focus for the entire time today they still had a lot of fun.

# GROUP TIME

During group time this morning Miss Briohny read 'Davey and the Duckling' to the children. We chose this story as ducks are one of the animals that live on the farm. Once we finished our story Miss Briohny and the children talked about some of the animals that live on the farm. As the children were a little confused we looked at some of the plastic animals. To finish our group time we sang 'Old McDonald' with the children choosing what animal came next.




# Reflection of the day
