SCARECROW COLLAGE



As we continued with our topic of The Farm this morning the children used pieces of coloured paper, googly eyes, a hat template and a paper plate to create their own versions of Scarecrows.

First they started by covering their plates with glue before pasting on two pink circles for blushed cheeks, a carrot nose, and either a happy or sad mouth. Next they stuck on some googly eyes. Once the face was finished they created their Scarecrows hat. They glued on a blue band on the hat before adding some red flowers. The children each chose a different amount of flowers for their hats. Once the scarecrows were finished we added some yellow straw hair. They are so cute.



FARM ANIMAL BIN



Spencer, Azalea, Nathaniel, Samik and Hanson spent some time exploring the farm animal sensory bin. Looking through the animals they each selected the animal they were interested in, Samik chose the pony, Spencer chose the horse while Nathaniel chose the cow. Using their recognition skills they identified the animals and the sound they made. Azalea enjoyed exploring the different textured materials that made up the grass as well as they different sized rocks. This activity encouraged the children to explore their creativity and imagination.



CLEAN THE PIG



As we continued with the farm Spencer, Mikayla and Hanson demonstrated kindness as they participated in the clean the pig activity. Selecting one of the pigs they picked up the cloth and started scrubbing the pigs clean. This activity strengthened the children's fine motor skills along with their hand-eye coordination.
