

# OUTDOOR



For outdoor play this morning, there were a few activities related to farm animals set up for the children to engage in. There was a sorting animal game where the children had to sort the coloured animal figures into the same coloured cup. Xin Yan was particularly good at this game as she carefully thought about which coloured cup the animal figures belonged in, rather than just placing all the animals into one cup. Spencer and Mikayla got involved in another farm animal activity where there were cups with images of a pig, dog and cow on top, and the task was to feed them with foods such as cut up scrap foods, grass and bones. Keaston and Mikayla and Keaston were interested in the farm animals that were placed in the sand trough for a sensory experience. They all had lots of fun in the outdoors engaging in a variety of activities this morning despite the gloomy weather.



# CARROT FOOTPRINTS



To continue with our topic of the farm, Miss Briohny and the children worked together today to create carrots. Using orange paint Miss Briohny painted one of the children's feet as they sat in the chair, before pressing their foot to the table. Each of the children had a different reaction to the feel of the paint brush running across their toes. Some of the children started giggling as the paint brush tickled their toes while some of the children sat still with out moving. Miss Briohny asked the children if they wanted to do multiple foot prints so each child created three carrot foot prints. Once the footprints are dry we will ass the leaves to the top of the carrots and a bit of crepe paper to create dirt.

# PROVOCATION FARM




On the table Miss Briohny set up a small world farm for the children to play with. Using a grass runner we made a field and we also put out the small barn. In small groups of two to three the children explored their creativity and imagination. Yoonu selected the donkey and pony and worked to place them inside the stalls of the barn. Violet and Olivia also included the dinosaurs to their play.

This activity allowed the children to demonstrate their recognition skills as they identified the different animals and the sounds they made.



# MUSIC

The children all loved music again today, packing up enthusiastically when they saw Mr B. They went through all of the things they have learnt in previous weeks and are starting to remember what comes next in the songs they are familiar with. Making the symbol noise with their mouth is still a favourite as well as freeze at the end. The children also love to dance with each other and the Educators and giggle as they dance around the mat. # GROUP TIME



During group time this morning Miss Briohny and the children talked about Fruit and Vegetables. On the easel Miss Briohny put up two charts, one for Veggies and one for fruit. Then together as a group we looked at some different pictures and the children used their recognition skill sot identify the different pictures. Once we were able to identify each picture we discovered if they belonged in the vegetable chart or the fruit chart.

After our fruit and vegetable discussion we moved on to reading "Bushranger Bill."
