ON THE FARM COLLAGE



As we continued our topic of on the farm the children created their own fruit and vegetable gardens this morning. On brown paper and crepe paper they spread out some glue before selecting the fruit and vegetable they were going to use. Once they had selected their fruit and vegetables they placed them out into their garden, some of the children selected one of each fruit or vegetable, while a couple of the children had multiples in their garden.

Miss Briohny and the children talked about the different vegetables and fruit, using their recognition skills to identify them. We discovered we had carrots, pumpkins, strawberries and corn. Once we had recognised the food we talked about some of the different animals that eat the foods we had. We discussed that pigs eat corn, cows eat grass, rabbits and horses eat carrots.

Tomorrow we will continue with food on the farm by creating our own apple trees using recycled bottles.


PEG LEG ANIMALS



The children engaged in a small group fine motor activity this morning. Selecting one of the farm animal pictures, they grabbed a small handful of pegs. Grasping the peg between their thumbs and forefinger they worked on opening the peg so they could slid it onto the farm animal. Once they understood the motion of the peg they were able to provide the different animals with legs. Yoonu enjoyed working with the animals as he was able to manipulate the pegs with ease, he also gave the animals tails.

This activity required the children to work with trial and error as they worked to manipulate the pegs to open and close. This also developed their problem solving skills as well as they development of their fine motor skills.

COLLECTING EGGS



The children got involved in a farm activity where the chicken would lay some eggs and the children would collect the eggs using their gentle hands and place them in the basket. They thoroughly enjoyed gathering the eggs and cracking them open. Miss Taylor demonstrated how we can crack an egg and cook it on a pan. The children would then tap the egg on a surface two or three times and pretend to drop it onto a pan to let it sizzle and cook. We then extended on the play by placing tiny coloured teddy figures into the egg and the children would crack it open to see a surprise toy inside. They had tons of fun with the eggs.



YOGA




GROUP TIME

Miss Briohny set up the story on her computer for the children to see the pictures and using the speakers we were able to listen to the story. As we listened to the story we heard the sounds of some of the different animals. Through our story we saw a sheep, a goat, a rooster, a dog, a cow, a horse and some piglets. The children enjoyed listening to the story and hearing the different sounds in the story.






Reflection of the day
