
WEEKLY TOPIC:

ON THE FARM







A reminder that tomorrow is RED NOSE DAY and we are asking the children to come dressed in their PYJAMAS again to help raise awareness for RED NOSE Day.



OUTDOOR PLAY




For outdoor play this morning, Spencer and Nate got involved in following the action cards where they would attempt balancing on one foot, do a squat, march, as well as skip around the playground. Keaston, Azalea, Spencer and Nate all enjoyed overcoming the obstacle course. Keaston, Spencer, and Nate also put on animal masks and would imitate the sounds of those animals. It was nice for the children to soak in some sunlight out in the big yard.



APPLE TREE PAINTING



Today the children used a recycled plastic bottle to create their own apple tree. Holding the bottle in their hand they dipped it into the green paint before stamping it across the paper to create the leaves of their tree. Once they had finished with the trees they dipped their finger into some red paint before pressing it across their tree to create their apples. While painting the children reach created unique apple trees. Tomorrow we will finish our topic of on the farm by creating some shape farm animals.



FARM SHOP



This morning a farm shop was set up for the children with all of the things we have been learning come from the farm. The children put on aprons and inspected all of the items. Miss Stacey sat with them and asked what items they had for sale. They were able to point out the carrots, watermelon, grapes, milk and eggs. Hanson decided to play with the cash register and the children took turns asking him for money. He handed each friend one note and one coin. Everyone had fun pretending to be shop keepers.



FARM ANIMAL SORT



We had the farm animals and coloured cups set up again for some farm animal sorting. The goal was for the children to place the coloured farm animals into the same coloured cup to challenge their colour recognition skills. Miss Taylor asked Hanson which cups the coloured animals belonged in and he pointed to the correct cups, but he then proceeded to place all the farm animals into a single cup which was more fun for him.



GROUP TIME

Miss Briohny and the children sat together at the mat this morning to talk about the different foods that we get from the farm. To start we looked at some flashcards of different food products and the children guess where they came from. Spencer was able to identify the foods that came from the ground like carrots, broccoli and potatoes. Once we had looked at the pictures the children and Miss Briohny started creating a list of some foods they thought came from the farm. Hanson suggested carrots and apples, Spencer said grapes and milk, Keaston said Bananas and pineapple while Olivia said capsicum and strawberries. Once we had finished our discussion we sang some farm songs. First we sang 'Baa Baa Black sheep', then 'Old McDonald' with the children choosing the animals and lastly we sang "B-IN-G-O".
