

SCIENCE WEEK






Miss Ginny came for Yoga this morning. Starting standing up the children made stars, having their feet out and their arms to the side. In their star position they stretched to one side before stretching to the other. Once they were finished they moved into their table position and then down into their snakes. They started as baby snakes before going into their cat and cow pose where they stretched their back before going down into their mummy snake pose then they came back up into their table pose before ending on a daddy snake pose. Once they were finished they stood up tall making trees, they held their hands behind their head and bent to the left before bending to the right. Once they had finished bending they sat on the mat together with their legs out in front of them ready to make their rockets. After their rockets they went into breathing. Today they used the expandable ball, as they took a breath in the ball went bigger and as they blew their breath out the ball shrunk. The children each got to have a turn holding the ball and practicing their breath. To end Yoga this morning they laid down on the mat on their back before stretching their arms above their head and Miss Ginny sprinkled some fairy dust on them.

SHAVING FOAM ART

We continued with our science week topic this morning by making some shaving foam art. Miss Briohny filled a tray with some shaving foam before adding some drops of food dye. Taking turns the children placed their paper into the tray, pressing it down into the foam, before we gently pulled it out to see the design it had made. Miss Briohny used a paddle pop stick to remove the excess shaving foam so the children could see the pictures they had created. They looked amazing with the different colours mixed together.



MIXING COLOURS





For an activity this morning, two different colours of paint were inserted in each giant ziplock bag. The children then had to mix the two different coloured paint to form a new colour. They would flatten the paint by placing their hands on top of the bag and even gave the bag a little shake. Miss Taylor asked the children to say aloud what the colours were before they were mixed, and what colour it was after it was mixed together. Their colour recognition skills has improved significantly as most could say aloud what each of the colours were.



SINK AND FLOAT



This science-related water play activity was an intriguing experience for the children. They were given a number of items and objects to test whether they would float or sink. The items included pipe cleaners, shells, rocks, and other small toys from our toy cupboard. They had lots of fun feeling the textures of the objects and splashing a little water around the activity table. Yoonu and Thomas particularly, spent lots of time sitting by the sink and float activity table, just sharing the objects with each other very nicely. Water play is always engaging.



During group time this morning we created our third science experiment. Today's ingredients were pea seeds, a paper towel, water and a Ziplock bag. To start Miss Briohny wet the paper towel and placed it into the bottom of the Ziplock bag, then we placed in three seeds and zipped the bag up tight. We will place the bag on the window in the bathroom and watch what happens.

Violet chose the story we read today. Today's story was "I'm Starting Nursery". It was a nice book about starting daycare. Once we had finished our story Miss Briohny and the children talked about our table manners. Using the small mirror table Miss Briohny showed the children how they sit with their tummies to the table to make sure they don't spill food on the floor. We also talked about keeping our feet under the table so we don't kick our friends and how it isn't nice to hit our bottle on the table. They did a great job remembering their manners at lunch.






Reflection of the day
