


STINGRAY DAILY STORY

OUTDOOR PLAY



During outdoor play, Keaston was looking at the flowers in the garden. Miss Stacey asked if he would like to water the plants and he said yes excitedly. They went together and collected a watering can and filled it up. Keaston shared the watering can with Mikayla, Spencer and Azalea and they watered all of the flowers together. The children also had fun running around the playground and going down the slide.

SPLAT PAINTING



For our science art activity today the children created splat paintings. Taking turns Miss Briohny handed the children one of the pom poms after we dipped it in the paint. Holding the pom pom up high the children dropped it onto their paper. As the pom poms hit the paper they created a splat texture. The children tested different heights to see the different patterns the pom poms created.





For a melting ice activity, there were items including straws, pom poms and confetti frozen in water. Blue and red food colouring was also added to the water to add colour and vibrancy. The goal was for the children to utilise droppers to pull up warm water from a cup and drop the water in the coloured ice in order to melt it and reveal the objects. Later on, Miss Stacey took initiative of using a toy hammer to try and smash the ice as it was difficult for the children to melt the ice. Overall, they had tons of fun exploring with ice play.

The children had so much energy this morning so Miss Stacey decided to put on some dancing music. Mikayla requested baby shark and the children did all the moves. We then did lots of songs that included familiar dance moves including Sleeping Bunnies, Can You Point Your Fingers and Do the Twist and The Ants Go Marching. GROUP TIME



Today the children joined Miss Briohny at one of the tables ready for today's science experiment. The materials for today's experiment were oil, warm water and food colouring. The children chose green food colouring today. Holding the food colouring over the oil we counted out 10 drops of food colouring, then using a stick Miss Briohny mixed the colour and oil together. Once that was ready we poured it into the warm water to watch what happened next. As we watched the bubbles in the oil started to pop in the warm water and the food colouring started to spread through the water like fireworks.
