


STINGRAY DAILY STORY

SCIENCE WEEK





Before lunch we had some outdoor play. The children loved being out in the sunshine. Mikayla asked Miss Taylor to chase her and all of the children giggled and ran through the playground to get away. Thomas and Yoonu took an interest in the blocks which were on the mat and proudly showed Miss Stacey their creations. Mikayla, Hanson, Xin Yan and Spencer looked at the dolls which are set up in buckets to wash later today. Marwin and Violet wanted to play in the sandpit and all of their friends followed. They used the shovels to dig holes and put sand into the trucks. We finished our outdoor play with a story. Miss Taylor read 'Mr Huff' to the children which has been a favourite story lately.

OUTDOOR PLAY



To end Science Week, the children engaged in a fun activity where two trays were filled with bicarb soda, and vinegar with blue, red, green and yellow food colouring were inserted in a squeeze bottle. The children would drizzle the vinegar with food colouring mixture onto the bicarb soda tray and observe and get excited over the reaction as it would fizz and form bubbles. Miss Taylor would ask the children to say aloud what colour bottle they were using and they would mention the right colours. This was such an exciting, science activity that not only enhances their fine motor skills, but also proves how intelligent they are with colour recognition.

SHAVING FOAM SENSORY BAGS



Some of the children today decided to have a play with the shaving foam sensory bags that were filled with a few drops of green, blue and yellow food colouring. The shaving foam enabled the kids to use their senses to feel the soft texture of the shaving foam. They would squish it around with their hands, flattening the foam and mixing the three colours to form one colour. This was a simple sensory experience that contributes to building the childrens' curiosity and creativity skills.







Reflection of the day
