

Farm animals in bark!





Harlow and Arden shared their animals with each other and Arden said, " Ta!" when Harlow handed her over a cow and babbled something in return. Good sharing, Girls!




What a fun time we had today, where children loved their outdoor environment while choosing activities of their choice.






This experience not only boosted the confidence of children but also helped in developing social skills in them while playing in a group.


