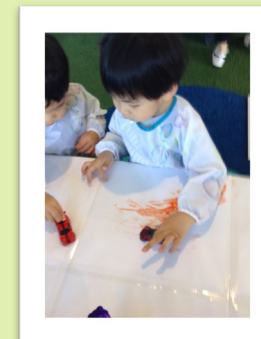
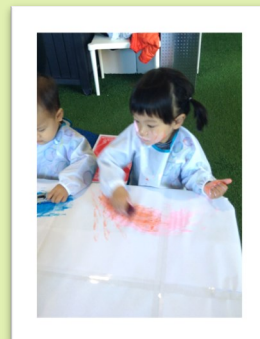
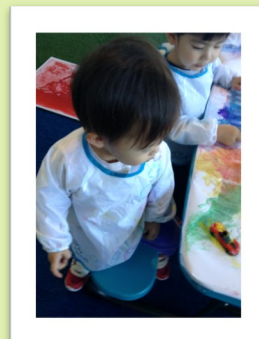
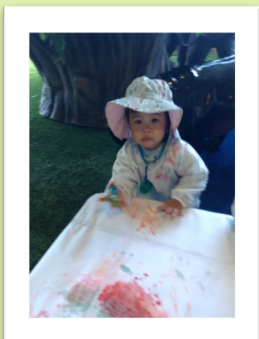
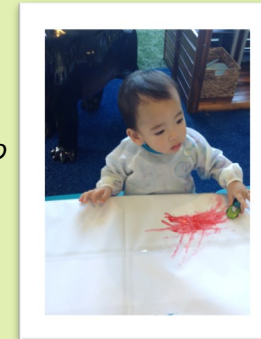
Group Car Painting

Throughout this experience, Miss Taylah and Miss Jade talked about each of the different colours they could see, as well as the sounds cars make. **Evan** was showing his educators how clever he is by saying the colours, red, yellow, blue and purple. **Harvey, Eleanor, Aria** and **Ayden** were repeating the sounds that Miss Taylah and Miss Jade were saying about the cars "Beep, Beep", "Broom, Broom", goes the children.

Archie was so funny today he had all the hair products out for all his friends to play with. His favourite was the hair dryer pretending to dry his hair.

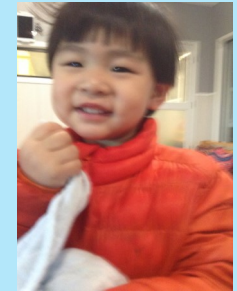
Ayden and **Olivia** were so engaged in our home corner area. They absolutely loved to make each other meals pretending to cut and slice different food items.

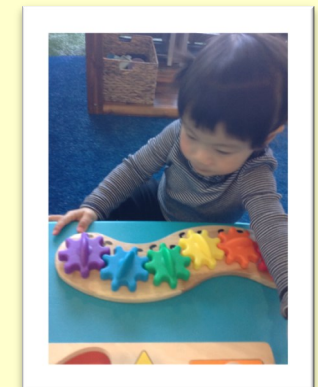
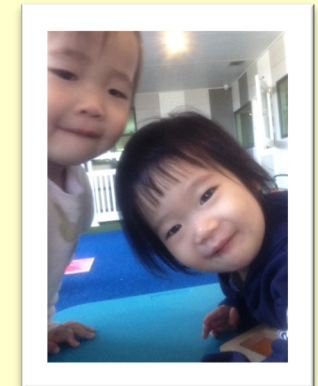
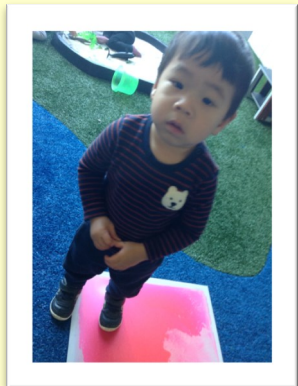
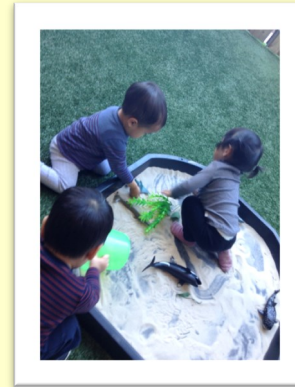
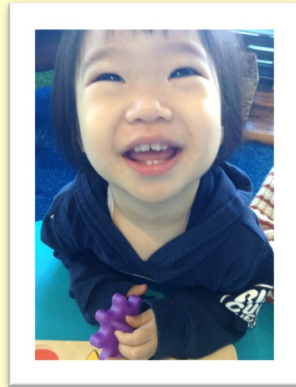
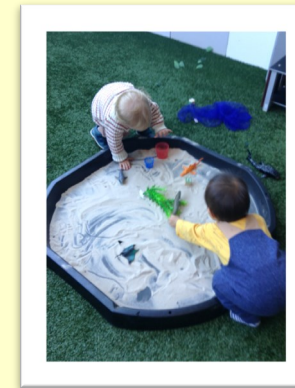
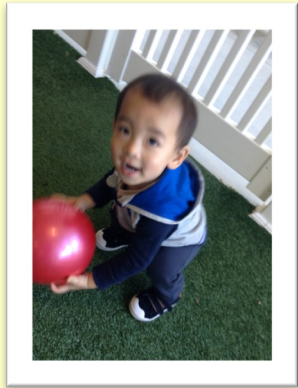
Ayden and **Ethan** were so good interacting with each other and playing with our toys and sharing with each other they liked the wooden toy where you could twist and turns the wooden circles.
