After morning tea, I put some contact paper on the door and stick some rings on it, a little bit higher and invited children to explore it.

Harlow and Arden quickly made their way to the activity and stood up confidently while grabbing the rings from the sticky paper and feeling the texture of paper by touching it with their fingers as well.

Soon Alina, Norah and Madeleine joined them and everyone loved to pull the rings from the paper and then stick it back. **Alina**, at first, tried to pull the lower rings and then she held the shelf nearby and tried to stand to grab the higher ones. I helped her in standing and she was able to grab a ring.

Children showed great interest in the activity and spent a good time on it.
